

## **The Father's Name**

<b>Matthew 28:19</b>	Name is singular. Nations more than one. What is the Savior's true name? What is the Father's name?
<b>Luke 24:47</b>	One name among all nations starting at Jerusalem.
<b>Psalms 72:17</b>	All nations blessed in Yahwah's name.
<b>John 5:43</b>	The Savior came in His Father's name. Whatever name the Father has the Son has also.
<b>John 17:6</b>	The Savior manifested (showed) the Father's name.
<b>Acts 4:12</b>	One name for salvation.
<b>Psalms 54:1</b>	Salvation through his name.
<b>Hebrews 1:4</b>	The Son inherited a more excellent name than the angels.
<b>Psalms 148:13</b>	Yahwah alone is excellent.

To find the Father's name you have to search the scriptures. When the Savior walked on the earth there was no New Testament written yet. They had to search the Old Testament scriptures.

<b>Luke 24:45</b>	Opened their understanding to the scriptures. What scriptures? The Old Testament.
<b>John 5:39</b>	Search the scriptures. The Old Testament.
<b>Acts 10:43</b>	Who were the prophets? Isaiah, Joel, Jeremiah, ect.
<b>Hebrews 1:1</b>	God spoke by the prophets.

To find the Son's name you have to find the Father's name. To find out the Father's name you have to go to the Old Testament. What name did the Old Testament and the Prophets give witness to?

<b>Genesis 22:14</b>	Every place you see the words LORD, GOD, Jehovah should have been the name of Yahwah. Abraham called on the name of Jehovah (Yahwah).
<b>Exodus 6:3</b>	God's name Jehovah (Yahwah)
<b>Exodus 17:15</b>	Another scripture testifying to the name Jehovah (Yahwah).
<b>Judges 6:24</b>	Another scripture testifying to the name Jehovah (Yahwah).
<b>Psalms 83:18</b>	God's name is alone Jehovah (Yahwah).

<b>Isaiah 12:2</b>	Jehovah (Yahwah) is our salvation.
<b>Isaiah 26:4</b>	All these scriptures use the name Jehovah (7 witnesses), not Jesus.
<p>The name Jehovah was brought in by the Roman Catholic Church by a man named Peter Gaudies in the 15<sup>th</sup> century. From our study so far there are two names Jehovah (Yahwah) in the Old Testament and Jesus in the New Testament. In Zech. 14:9 it says “and the LORD shall be king over all the earth: in that day shall there be one LORD, and his name one.” The words LORD, GOD, and Jehovah have hid the truth of the name of our Savior. The name Jesus is only about 300-400 years old.</p>	
<b>Eph. 4:4-6</b>	One Lord, one faith, one baptism. Also one name.
<b>Isaiah 42:8</b>	LORD is not a name, it is a title. In the original Hebrew it read I am Yahwah, that is my name.
<b>Jeremiah 50:34</b>	Yahwah is the Redeemer.
<b>Jeremiah 23:6</b>	This scripture is a prophesy of the coming Messiah. It says that his name is Yahwah our righteousness.
<b>Psalms 68:4</b>	This scripture shows part of the name Yahwah (Yah). There is no J in the Hebrew alphabet. The word Hallelujah means praise Yahwah.
<b>Joel 2:32</b>	Whoever calls on the name of Yahwah will be saved.
<b>Acts 2:21</b>	Peter quoted from Joel. He would not have said two different names for salvation in the same chapter.
<b>Psalms 118:26</b>	The Savior was to come in the name of Yahwah.
<b>Matt. 21:9</b>	The above scripture is fulfilled.
<b>Isaiah 43:11</b>	Yahwah says that beside him there is no Savior.
<b>Isaiah 45:21-23</b>	Verse 23 says that to Yahwah every knee shall bow and every tongue swear.
<b>Phil. 2:9-11</b>	The Savior has a name above every name.
<b>Romans 14:11</b>	Quote from Isaiah
<b>Acts 2:38</b>	Plan of Salvation. Baptism in the name of Yahwah the Messiah.
